Lister Learning & Teaching Centre, Roxburgh Place

This project, in two main phases, involves the refurbishment of two teaching and lecture facilities at Roxburgh Place, and a new a new 5-storey link building that creates better access and circulation space between the two buildings.

It was procured under the Scape National Major Works framework, which enabled a swift turnaround from the preconstruction stage to starting work on site.

Phase 1 was handed over on time in September 2017, releasing 22 teaching spaces. Works included:

- New temporary entrance into Lister building from Roxburgh Place
- Designing and completing temporary works within lecture theatre
- Additional partitions screening Phase 1 works from later Phases 2 and 4
- Reconfiguration of M&E services
- Procuring and creating new temporary reception area including raised floors, platforms, partitions, external and internal doors, and finishes.
- Reconfiguring site layout and hoarding

- 69 student visits to site
- 60 college student workshops
- 14 University students experience on site
- 21 work experience placements under 17 years old
- 33 work experience placements over 18 years old
- 15 apprentices, totalling 104 weeks of experience
- 13 NVQs completed
